### Unit II: "Purity Matters"

#### Known: Relationships

True Love Waits challenges student to commit to sexual purity because that is the biblical standard. Yet, purity is more than just not having sex until you are married—purity is a lifestyle choice.

This is a four-session KNOWN study under the Relationships category. Students will be challenged to live out their faith in God and their biblical convictions by demonstrating purity not only sexually, but also in their speech and thoughts. A lifestyle of purity can be a powerful witness to those who don't know Christ.
