Today's Guest Speaker

Rev. Leroy Fountain serves as a Church Planting consultant with the North American Mission Board. He is a career missionary appointed as a church planter in November of 1983. While Leroy was working toward his master of Divinity degree at the ITC's Morehouse School of Religion, he

became acquainted with the church planting efforts of the Southern Baptist convention. His first church planting call came from the Browns Mill Park Baptist Church in Atlanta. He was appointed as a Church Planter Missionary by the Home Mission board (now the North American Mission Board) in 1983 and was sent to help start Central Baptist Church in Montgomery, Alabama. After two years, he was called to pastor the Southlawn Annuity Board (now Guide Stone Financial Resources) of the Southern Baptist Convention in Dallas, Texas as a regional manager and financial planner. When he left Guide Stone, he returned to his ministry passion as a church Planter Strategist with the Southern Baptist of Texas Convention. Now he brings his zeal for church planting to the North American Mission Board as he continues the work of identifying and supporting new church planting opportunities in the United States and the Virgin Islands. He believes that planting new churches is the key to developing an evangelist process that will help people to be transformation agents in the neighborhoods where they live. He believes that it is then that persons can begin to lead other people to Christ and help the church become a beacon of light where they live and work.

He and his wife, Carolyn have been married 31 years. They have three daughters. Charena who lives in Los Angeles, CA, Marsha, a member of Greenforest and a recent graduate of Stillman College in Tuscaloosa, AL and Bridgette who is a graduating senior at Spelman College in Atlanta. Leroy's love for the Lord is reflected by his love for his family and for God's people.
