### SAFETY TIPS (Part II)

#### Personal Safety

- \* When out and about don't look like a victim or "easy mark". People who appear to be observant and aware of their surroundings are far less likely to become victims of personal crime.
- \* Park as close to the entrance as possible-day or night (new or well kept car owners tend to park away from other cars, would-be thieves know this).
- \* At night, park in a well lit area where lots of other cars are parked; walk with the flow of the crowd-there's usually safety in numbers.
- \* Avoid wearing or displaying expensive jewelry when out alone, especially at night.
- \* Put your money away "before" you leave the store. Be aware if someone may be watching you, or may be following you as you leave the store or building. If you feel that is the case, immediately turn around and go back inside. If necessary, tell someone or call security for an escort.
- \* Invest in a can of pepper spray and keep it handy, especially at night. It may buy you some precious time to escape if attacked (keep out of reach of children).
- \* Buy a referee's whistle (5 bucks at Walmart), it can be used to attract attention if you are threatened.

Let us not be fearful, instead, let us use the Sound Mind God gave us.
