**History of the Text – The Acts of the Apostles**

1. Part 2/2 which began with the Gospel Luke
2. 5<sup>th</sup> book of the bible. 5 is the number of Grace.
3. Chronicles the work of Holy Spirit through the Apostles
4. Written by Luke

  - a. Luke was more specific, comprehensive, thorough and intentional than the other gospel writers.

  - a. Luke was very strict about the fact Jesus was a Jew trying to reach Jews & Gentiles.

  - a. Luke is is clear that Jesus is fully human (Son of Mary) and divine (God the Son).

    - a. Wanted the world to know that Jesus wasn't just a preacher, teacher, and healer but a liberator (Jesus "Yesh-ua)" meaning God's saves.

    - a. Luke wrote these 2 books knowing it could cost him his life.

    - a. So committed to the growth of Christianity that he becomes the historian/curator of the early church history.

**How is the Book of Acts broken down?**

1. Acts 2:1-13 – Day of Pentecost
2. Acts 2:14-41 – Peter preaches & 3,000 get saved
3. Acts 2:42-47 – The Holy Habits of the Early Church

1. **Daily Discipleship (v.42)**
  - a. Greek word for teaching is *didache*
2. **Genuine Fellowship (v.42)**
  - a. Fellowship in Greek is *koinonia*
3. **Prayer-filled Relationships (v.42)**
  - a. Greek word for prayer is *proseuche*
4. **Sacrificial Stewardship (v.45)**
  - a. Greek word for sold is *paprisko*
5. **Selfless Servantship (v.46)**
  - a. Greek word for daily is *kata*
6. **Undignified Worship (v.47)**
  - a. Greek word for Praising is *aineo*
